and PNCC are affiliated with;

- Continuing to provide benefits to its members in the above mentioned items;
- Continuing to provide stipends and scholarships for higher education of its members:
- Continuing to support the Spojnia Credit Union and promote its use to the members:
- Continue to support and govern with the PNCC the Bishop Hodur Retreat and Recreation Center.

The Polish National Union will merge its insurance offerings with another fraternal to afford members additional benefits by:

- Obtaining a merger partner that aligns with the values of the PNU and that of its members:
- Obtaining a merger partner that has a strong balance sheet in order to protect the members of the PNU without question;
- Obtaining a merger partner that will welcome our members as family from day one in benefits and governance;
- Obtaining a merger partner that will provide our members with additional benefits to best serve their needs.

What does this mean to me as a member of the PNU? This announcement will have no effect on you the member of the PNU. The policy that you have with the PNU will be transferred to the merging company in full. All benefits, beneficiaries, and ownership will not change.

Can I still purchase insurance from the PNU? Yes, until the merger of the insurance business is complete the PNU will continue to sell its insurance products and annuities without interruption.

Will my life insurance policy still be covered and/or paid out?

Yes: As a part of the merger agreement the new fraternal company assumes the liability of the promised benefit listed in a member's certificate. A letter of assumption will be generated and sent to each member by the surviving company.

Is my annuity money safe?

Yes: As a part of the merger agreement the new fraternal company assumes the liability of the promised benefit listed in a member's certificate. A letter of assumption will be generated and sent to each member by the surviving company.

Do I still need to pay my insurance premiums?

Yes: Premiums are payable to the PNU until the merger is complete and then paid to the

new company. As records are updated the surviving company will issue a bill on the same interval, Annual, Semi-annual, Quarterly, or Monthly as you are accustomed to receiving from the PNU.

What happens to the PNU officers, Board Members, and employees of PNU?

This is yet to be determined based on the merger agreement. On an officer and board level it is typical that they would remain involved in the surviving company as an advisory body to help with transition.

Should parishes continue to submit annual annuity payments for their pastors as required by the PNCC Clergy Salary & Benefits commission?

Yes: The annuity as well as the clergy insurance programs involve insurance and annuity contracts issued to individual members and will be treated as certificates assumed by the new fraternal company. In fact the new fraternal company may be able to offer a better return on the annuity than the PNU due to the size of the new company.

How is the Spojnia Credit Union impacted?

The Spojnia Credit Union is an independently incorporated entity created with a common bond of serving members of the PNU and organizations of the PNCC. It is likely that the charter having the common bond of the SCU will be modified to serve the members of the surviving entity and the members of the PNCC. In essence the merger will be beneficial because it will allow the SCU to expand its field of membership. Please keep in mind that the SCU is regulated by the NCUA and the PA Banking Department. Because of this, deposits are federally insured up to \$250,000 through the NCUA.

As can be seen these are exciting times for you the member of the PNU. While the PNU has fulfilled the mission set forth by Prime Bishop Francis Hodur regarding providing life insurance policies to members of the PNCC who could not obtain insurance in the past, the mission of fraternalism, community service, educational excellence and support of the PNCC continues.

As your CEO, I am excited with all the new possibilities that this new direction of the PNU will have for you the member. The ability to provide you the member with more benefits, more ways to participate in cultural activities, continued support of the PNCC and the Spojnia Credit Union this is a win/win for everyone. While the PNU was limited on its offerings of insurance, the fraternals we are negotiating with have more items they offer. As we continue down this path there will be more announcements made by the Board through me so stay tuned.

The PNU is now strategically positioning itself for the next 115 Years and beyond!!!!






